Church Council News

Church Council met Monday, July 21. Official minutes will be available in the office after they are approved by the full Council next month. The following is a list of some of the important items discussed.

- 1) One new medicine cabinet has been installed in the parsonage's bathroom. Another will be installed soon in another parsonage bathroom.
- 2) According to our Safe Sanctuary Policy, all volunteers and staff who work with children MUST have background checks for sexual abuse. This had been disregarded in the past and we will start this process again.
- 3) There is an interest in joining one of the Hatching Faith Cohorts through our conference. Hatching Faith Cohorts are groups of 10-20 churches who try new or innovative ways to have children involved in church and share what worked and what didn't. If anyone is interested in being involved in this initiative, please see Rev. Perez.
- 4) We are still working with our contractor for replacing the HVAC in Fellowship Hall. Securing units has been the main problem. All units should be available soon and the outside work should be started soon. We apologize for the delays.
- 5) For anyone who noticed, Rev. Miller's name is still on our outside sign. New lettering has been ordered and hopefully will be up soon.
- 6) Our AV Team has met with an AV specialist from the Conference and were happy to learn not as much NEW equipment is needed as was thought. Hopefully you will notice a better sound system right away.
- 7) We are also looking at some changes for the choir loft to make it more accessible to all of our choir members. In the meantime, they will be sitting in the first few rows of the congregation and sing in front of the altar.
- 8) We will be rewriting our budget to update salary changes.
- 9) Rev. Perez shared information from the conference regarding the demographics of our town and county to assist us in looking forward of what our Urbanna UMC can help our community and what we can become.

As Council Chair, I would like to thank all who were involved in our receptions to say goodbye to Pastor Mark and Lynn, and to welcome Rev. Perez and Katrina. They were both successes and great fellowship time. To all who helped with set up, who supplied all the delicious food, and who helped with clean-up: Thank you!
